The Prescott Chamber Orchestra is a volunteer group of 30 to 35 talented local musicians who, under their music director, Dr. Philip Kuhns, perform classical music concerts for the Prescott Community. Founded in 1981 by violinist, string teacher and former Prescott High School orchestra director, Raymond Henderson, the Prescott Chamber Orchestra has steadily grown from its origins as a small string ensemble known as the Prescott Strings, into today's symphonic chamber orchestra having added wind, brass and percussion instruments.

An important part of the orchestra's mission is student education. By actively seeking and inviting more advanced area music students to join the orchestra, it provides them the opportunity to develop their orchestral skills while studying, rehearsing and performing great orchestral literature in the company of more experienced musicians.

Other educational goals of the orchestra include the development of outreach programs to local schools and youth organizations, as well as the establishment of music scholarships for students who need assistance with musical instrument purchases, private lessons, camps, workshops, and/or higher education costs.

For the orchestra to continue its mission and realize its goals, it will require funding from the local community. Why make a planned gift?

Aside from the following financial benefits, a planned gift is a profound way to leave a legacy or create a memorial for an organization and cause that holds deep meaning for you, the donor.

Though benefits vary depending on the gift you choose, many of our giving options share these features:

- An immediate federal income tax deduction for all, or a portion, of the value of the gift.
- Elimination of capital gains tax at the time of the transfer if the asset is in the form of securities or real estate that have appreciated in value.
- Increased financial security for you or your heirs while providing meaningful support for the Prescott Chamber Orchestra.
- Income for life paid to you and/or another beneficiary, such as your spouse or another family member.
- Increased income if a gift is made to a life-income plan that produces a higher yield than the donated asset, which is often the case with securities.
